Objectives

Implement and design a low cost automobile robot where the below mentioned tasks shall be covered.

- Analysis of technical and operational requirement to implement robotic solution.
- Firmware/ software development and testing (Arduino, ROS)
- Work across the entire the development of a small mobile robot.

Registration

Via the online portal at <http://robotcraft.ingeniarius.pt/site/> , please look at the deadlines for the registration.

Also be aware that in order to confirm your acceptance of the program you have pay the required fees: 300€ within the deadlines mentioned in our portal.

Once you get accepted and you have paid the fees, you will be able to get an acceptance letter duly signed and sealed from the company stating that your spot has been booked, which you will need for your visa application.

*Note: If you are applying for the university internship course please let us know in advance, so we can be able to provide the required papers for your Jordanian University to accept the Internship.

Applying for Visa

As soon as you get your acceptance letter, you need to start your visa application, please note at some cases it might take a month for the visa to be issued, as well the visa need to be applied and collected in PERSON.

Since there is no Portuguese Embassy in Jordan, you will need to apply through the Spanish Embassy due to its the closest country to Portugal. Application and appointments can be made through

The course is only two month, therefore you will need to apply as a short term visa (up to 90 days).

Required documents:

- Completely filled and signed application form.
- Valid passport and a copy of it.
- Letter of acceptance you got from Ingeniarius.
- 3 passport size photographs (white background. Avoid white or bright clothes).
- Travel medical insurance covering the period of stay with a value of at least 30,000 Euro.
- Proof of sufficient financial means. Bank statement + certificate from a bank in Jordan showing movements of the applicant's account for the last three months, signed and sealed by the bank.
- Work certificate including position, salary and date of starting the post, if you are an university student, a paper from the university stating you are a registered student.
- Reservation of accommodation in Portugal. (see accommodation section)
- Flight reservation (since you are applying though the Spanish embassy, Spain should be your first destination, so it is better to book a transit flight to Spain, then Portugal).

Arriving to Coimbra

There is no airport in Coimbra, but there are several ways to get there:

- Airplane to Lisbon

Coimbra by Train

Take the metro from the airport to “Oriente” or you can take a taxi to “Gare do Oriente”, then take a train to Coimbra.

Coimbra by Bus

Use the metro to get to “Sete Rios” and get the bus to Coimbra.

- Airplane to Porto

Coimbra by Train

Take a metro from the airport to “Campanhã” and get the train to Coimbra

Coimbra by Bus

Go to “S. Bento” and look for the bus station, at Rua Alexandre Herculano, in Praça da Batalha.
